By filing out this indication of interest you are not committing to sales or delivery of biomass, but we expect you will be given first consideration when the time comes to contract biomass purchases. The prices and tonnages provided are of critical importance to secure a fuel contract and create the biomass co-operative, so please be thoughtful and as accurate as possible in your answers. Please indicate the following:

- a) The approximate distance from your farm and fields to the intersection of Hwy 151 and 19 in Sun Prairie. _____ miles
- b) For each of the biomass crops listed, please indicate the price you would expect to receive for the material in the field. For corn stover that is lying in the field after combining and grasses are standing grass. Harvest and transportation costs are not needed at this time. Also please take into consideration that all ash (nutrients) would be returned to the field.

Pricing: indicate the lowest \$/ton DM you would need to be paid to sell the unharvested biomass crop and acres available per year, under the assumption the nutrients are returned to the field. Acres may be calculated using partial harvest of corn stover. If this is the case, indicate desired harvest amount or years of rotation in the comments section.

Example: If an operation has 1,000 acres of stover available and \$20/ton is expected and 50% removal of the stover is acceptable, indicate as follows. (If crop is not available, leave blank.) If more biomass is available at different price levels, indicate as such by creating a new line at the expected price level.
